The toys were delivered to the schools in January. With holiday vacations, a resurgence of COVID and unscheduled school snow days, distribution to the children was more challenging than expected. However, each school rose to the occasion in their own creative way.

At ASBA, the toys were given to many children. They also added some of the toys to their extended day program so more children could enjoy them.

At St. Gall's, we were so proud of our scholarship students who had the pleasure of distributing the toys to surprised and thrilled Pre-K -2^{nd} graders. They first introduced our charity to the children and then presented each child with a bag that contained a toy. The children screamed, jumped, clapped and loved their toys.



When we delivered the toys to Visitation, we were greeted at the door by our scholarship students! They swooped in to gather up the toys to bring into the school. Later, they helped determine the best way to distribute them to the students. The plan was a great success, handing out the toys as a surprise Valentine's Day treat. Sure beats candy!

On Feb 5th, we were delighted when our volunteers helped us deliver 296 bags and boxes to Savers, weighing in at 3,434 pounds.


We were once again overwhelmed by everyone's generosity. Savers provided a nice donation to Jim's Bridge for all we collected.
